



Donation and Sponsorship Guidelines

LABIDCO is dedicated to being a responsible and ethical corporate citizen. As part of our Corporate, Social, Responsibility (CSR) Policy, LABIDCO provides grants or contributions to legally registered, non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and community-based organisations (CBOs) that request support for an activity or project.

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for support, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a legally registered NGO or CBO.
- Submit an official letter of request or proposal detailing the initiative, including an itemized budget, to info.labidco@ngc.co.tt
- Clearly state the requested or desired contribution.
- Provide official banking information, including an account in the name of the organization.
- Specify the target audience and expected impact of the initiative.

Note: Priority will be given to initiatives that directly benefit residents of LABIDCO's fence line community, La Brea.

Application Process

Interested organizations should submit their applications via email to info.labidco@ngc.co.tt , including all required documentation. Applications will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, with preference given to initiatives that align with LABIDCO's CSR objectives and focus areas.

CSR Policy Limitations/Restrictions:

LABIDCO will not support any of the following:

- Private commercial ventures.
- Political parties and their affiliates.
- Religious activities aimed at advancing specific religious doctrines (except in cases where the beneficiary is secular, participation is unrestricted, and the event is open to the public).
- Private foundations, family foundations, and fraternal organizations.

- Activities that promote gambling, alcohol, tobacco, or pornography.
- Initiatives that perpetuate negative advertising images.
- Activities or organizations that are harmful to humans, animals, or the environment.
- Entities that provide or promote financial or other related services indirectly or directly.
